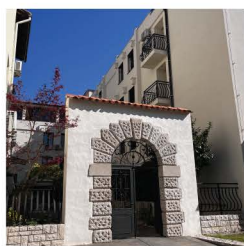
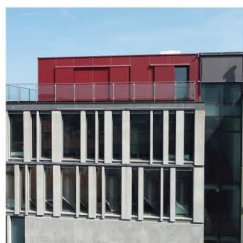

6 (Poor)	E (Sufficient)	Knowledge which meets the minimum criteria.
5 - 1 (Unsatisfactory)	F, FX (Fail)	Knowledge which does not meet the minimum criteria.
